If you can read this document then you have the Adobe Acrobat Reader correctly installed on your computer. This lets you view PDF files within your browser.

Here's a tip on how to save a PDF file to your hard drive from the web:

1. Locate the hyperlink that you clicked to go to the PDF document – right-click it.
2. In the subsequent popup dialog box, choose the option “Save Target As...”
3. Choose the proper directory to store the PDF file.
4. Now at any time you can use your File Explorer to locate the file and double-click it, which will open the Acrobat Reader.

To try this out, click your browser's back key to go to the previous page and then right-click on the link to this page. You should see a popup menu – choose “Save Target As...”. It will save this file to your hard drive in the directory of your choice!

That's It!

You may now close this browser (*click the “X” in the upper right hand corner*) and return to the Financial Psychology web site.
